Loss of propulsion "EEMSLIFT HENDRIKA" in North Sea

Location: Norwegian Sea

Impact: marine hull exposure

Issued by Skytek: at 08:00 GMT on 08 Apr 2021 - Update 2

Summary: Skytek React tracks in real time that drifting pattern of "Eemslift Hendrika", IMO: 9671486 has been brought under control by the salvage tugs sent on site.

There was no pollution involved, but from the 3 small yachts carried on deck, it is reported that AQS vessel, worth EUR 6.6 million was reportedly lost at sea.

The ship currently being towed by Smit Salvage tug "NORMAND DROTT", and assisted on site by coastguard boat "KV Sortland", and tug "BB OCEAN" underway at 2,6 knots towards Alesund, Norway.

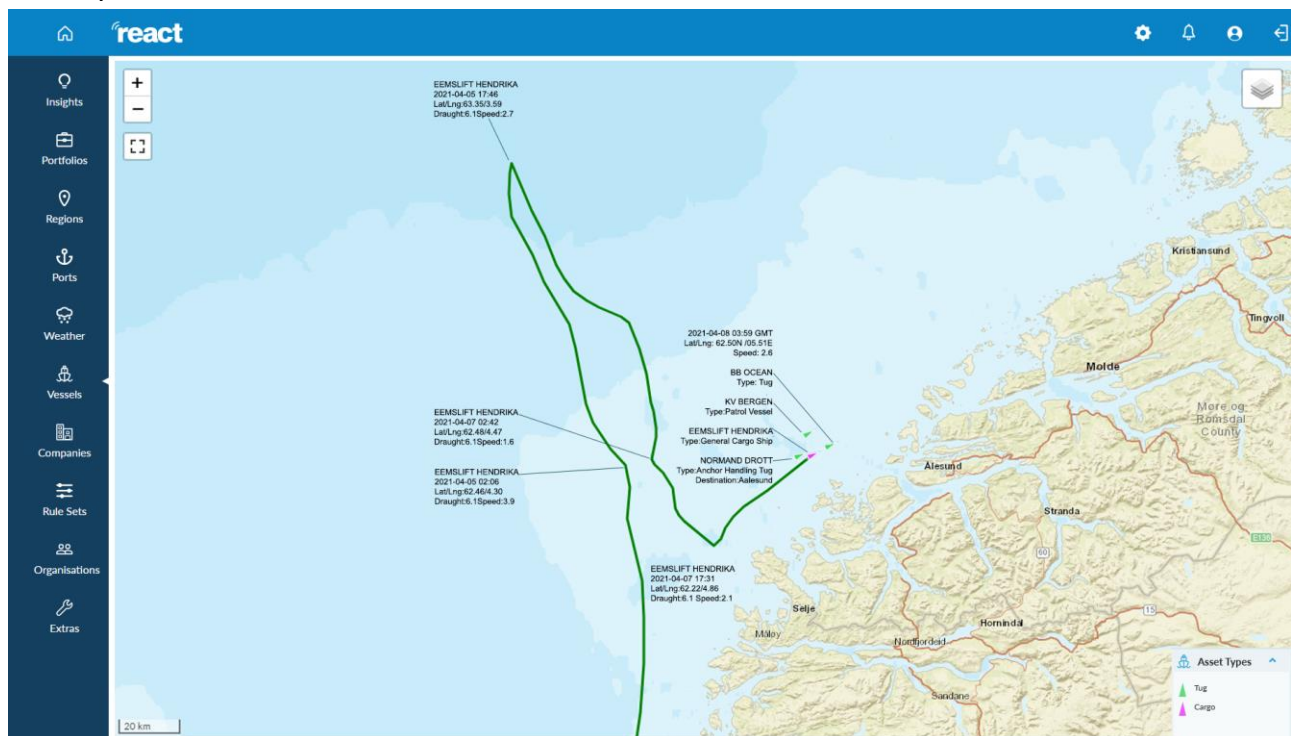


Figure 1 - Skytek React tracks "EEMSLIFT HENDRIKA" being towed to Alesund, 08 Apr 2021
